eatBute is a 3-day festival aimed at celebrating food production in Argyll & Bute, during Scottish Food Fortnight. Promoting some of the very best food and drink that Scotland has to offer, eatBute highlights the region as a sustainable food tourism destination and encourages visitors to the area. A food/tourism trade day is planned in conjunction with Caledonian MacBrayne and a launch dinner will mark the start of the festival.

Children's activities (to be run in partnership with the joint school campus and Achievement Bute,) interactive food sessions, a two-day farmers' market, a Bute Ceilidh and food trails are among the planned activities. The event will also encourage healthy eating and promote the schools based "Hungry for Success" programme and the Food for Life Campaign.

The key aims of the event are -

- Encouraging domestic tourism to the region during a traditionally quiet period, with a particular focus on encouraging repeat visitors annually.
- Developing Bute as a food tourism destination, thus attracting a new, lucrative market of visitors.
- Establishing a prestigious annual event on the island to encourage repeat visitors.
- Showcasing Bute's Food Heritage.
