# \* 23. CAMPBELTOWN MARINA PROPOSALS/ALL WEATHER PITCH FACILITY FUNDING

A report detailing the current position and viability of two proposed capital projects in Campbeltown that have previously been considered at CHORD Boards and outlining how funding can be allocated was considered along with a recommendation from the CHORD Programme Management Board.

#### Decision

The Executive agreed:-

- 1. To note the contents of the report;
- 2. In line with CHORD governance arrangements, to recommend to the Council the reallocation of a proportion of the capital allocation for Campbeltown CHORD (£480,000) towards an All Weather Pitch facility; and
- 3. To note that the Marina proposal as envisaged thus far is not financially viable and accept that work will be carried out to establish the viability of an alternative proposal within the resources which remain available to the Campbeltown CHORD Project.
