**3. CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982: APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF TAXI DRIVER'S LICENCE (M MACKENZIE, DUNOON)**

The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting and introductions were made. She outlined the procedure that would be followed and invited the Applicant to speak in support of his Application.

**Applicant**

Mr MacKenzie advised that he had applied for a Taxi Driver's Licence as there had been no other jobs for long enough. He advised that he had been in touch with taxi companies in the area and they confirmed they were looking for additional drivers.
