WINTER SERVICE PROVISION ON C32 GLEN LONAN ROAD

1. PURPOSE

To inform Members of the current status of C32 Glen Lonan Road, within the 2013-14 Winter Service Policy agreed by Full Council, October 2013.

2. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 Members note the information given in the report regarding the hierarchy of treatment route priorities within the Winter Service Policy and the trigger for escalation to pretreatment, for additional sections of the network travelled by School Transport vehicles, out with the Priority 2 pre-treatment regime.
- 2.2 Members confirm agreement with Roads Officers' assessment that the current status of C32 Glen Lonan road is a WRC4 (Winter Route Category 4 "next most important roads" for treatment) due to the current arrangement of two individual school bus trips to Taynuilt carrying less than 12 passengers each.

3 DETAILS

3.1 Winter Service Policy.

- 3.1.1 The Winter Service Policy and Plans were reviewed in 2008 to assess the requirements to comply with Working Time Directive and Drivers' Hours Regulations. The previous "24 hrs Service" expectation was not practicable within the available driver establishment, funded by the Winter Revenue budget.
- 3.1.2 It was recognised that a priority of routes would be required to provide a level of service appropriate for the hierarchy of each road section on the network. The current Priority 1-4 list, section 4 of the Winter Policy, is contained in **Appendix 1**This indicates the levels of service achievable within the confines of the current establishment available through the core revenue budget for the Winter Service. The level of service provided is above average within Scottish Local Authorities, with 52% of the public road network able to be pre-treated within 2 hrs.
- 3.1.5 Priority 3a indicates School Bus Routes. As it is not practicable to pre-treat every "route to school" from its origin, it was necessary to introduce a limit on this commitment to treat within 2hrs of mobilisation. The limit agreed by Council, was that of 12 occupied passenger seats, as this reduced the expectation that all routes, including those school runs by standard cars or MPVs, could be treated in advance

3.2 C32 Glen Lonan Winter treatment regime.

- 3.2.1 The pre-treatment route description L3, which leaves Oban and treats bus service and schools entrances in Dunbeg, Connel and Taynuilt before proceeding to cover the main Priority 2/3 Service Bus route B845 Taynuilt to Kilchrenan and C29 to Dalavich is contained in **Appendix 2**
- 3.2.2 The "Next most important" roads categorised as WRC4, was introduced in 2010 to guide vehicles to the next list of priorities, when hazards persist, after the commitments to complete pre-treatment routes has been achieved. Glen Lonan is designated as WRC4 Description list and map for LORN area is attached in **Appendix 3**
- 3.2.2 An annual check on School Bus routes out with these roads confirms the actual number of pupils being carried at any one time. The assessment of the school runs in the Glen Lonan area are included in the notes of a full assessment carried out in 2012 and clarification given in 2013. Assessment notes and 2013 email attached in **Appendix 4**

4. **CONCLUSIONS**

- 4.1 The assessment of risk is carried out regularly and the Winter Plan amended as necessary. The passenger numbers each trip do not require an upgrade of the current status of C32 as a WRC4 (Priority 4) route within the Winter Service Policy.
- 4.2 The time constraints involved in providing the present level of Winter Service within the available budget and establishment figures of drivers and treatment vehicles, mean that extension of pre-treatment routes is impracticable in the Lorn area. Likely vehicles to assist are the Kilchrenan Dalavich vehicle or the Oban Town vehicle, both of which have no spare capacity to extend their routes and still comply with the 2hr completion.



Manse Brae R Drive :- R&A \ WINTER MAINTENANACE \ TREATMENT ROUTES 2011-12\Word versions - 31,10,11




Winter Route Descriptors for WINTER ROUTE CATEGORY - 4s by Area

OBAN, LORN and the ISLES

WRC4 – Reactive routes (see Pre-treatment files for WRC 1-3 priority routes)

WRC4s are follow on Routes, contained within the 48% of the Council network, out with the scope of pretreatment plans, designated as Priority 4. These routes are identified as "next most important" and are to be treated first, in lasting conditions after 8 a.m. or when otherwise instructed. In addition to this, any hazardous conditions observed while treating the P1 & P2 /3 Routes shall be reported to the WM/DM and, if instructed to do so, treated. All other routes within Priority 4 will be treated when resources are available and hazards persist.

Total 4 passengers - Trip 1 (3 beyond pre-treatment route)

Taynuilt Primary : - 1nr Duntachan, 6nr Barguillean - Glenlonnan and 1 nr Taynuilt.

Total 8 passengers - Trip 2 (7 beyond pre-treatment route)

Conclusion

The Pre-treatment route L3 treats C32 within Taynuilt village as far as the old sawmill turning area, in conjunction with Taynuilt Primary School road and Brochroy circle before proceeding to B845 Kilchrenan and C29 Dalavich , Service Bus route P3a. There is limited time capacity for this vehicle to extend the works carried out prior to commencing the main purpose of the treatment run and still comply with the Priority 3a treatment completion times.

The current passenger numbers on the C32 beyond Lonan House from Taynuilt are limited and below the numbers which would necessitate inclusion in the pre-treatment route plan.

C32 Glen Lonan to remain a WRC4 "Next most important road" within the policy.
