further to your email of 7th October I would like to apply to the Community Safety Forum on behalf of the KCPP for funding of £466-80p.

<u>The Project</u> is for the members of the KCPP to circulate 1,500 beer mats to licensed premises throughout Kintyre to promote the <u>safety messages</u> of 'Dont drink and Drive' on one side of the beer mat (including numbers of local taxi firms) and 'Had a drink? Call time on domestic abuse' on the other side with phone numbers for Argyll and Bute Women's Aid and Victim Support Scotland.

If successful we can change the design slightly to include the logo and sponsorship of the Community Safety Forum.

## What it does.

The idea is to work in partnership with the Police's anti drink driving campaign over the festive season and also include contact details for domestic abuse in the hope it will act as a reminder for people to behave responsibly.

## For Who.

The general public visiting licensed premises throughout Kintyre, Gigha and possibly Islay (if deemed appropriate).

In the past we have printed the beer mats through Krisp Print as they have been very helpful in advising us as it is not that straightforward (3mm bleed areas around the beer mat) and the order has to be sent away for printing. I have received a quote from Krisp Print (attached) at £389 (excluding VAT) for 1500 beer mats. With 20% VAT the cost will be £466-80p.
