SCHEDULE OF CONDITIONS – LATE HOURS CATERING

General Conditions

1. The licence holder shall display the licence on the premises to which it relates and shall not in any way alter, erase or deface his licence
2. The Licence holder shall be permitted to trade in or from the above premises, and no other premises, in terms of this licence
3. The Licence holder shall comply with any order given by the Police or the Licensing Authority for the prevention of annoyance to the public, the occupiers of any premises or in connection with any emergency, disturbance or on any other occasion when they may consider it necessary in the public interest to give such an order or instruction.
4. Any licence holder who holds a licence as a street trader shall also comply with the conditions of such a licence, not inconsistent with this licence, as if such conditions were conditions of his late hours catering licence.
5. The Licence Holder must adhere to the relevant Building Control regulations relating to the maximum number of persons permitted within the premises at any one time.

Noise Conditions

6. The Licence holder shall ensure that no amplified music or sounds of any description are emitted from the premises in such a manner as to be audible to person's out-with the premises.

People

7. The Licence holder shall ensure that no patrons are permitted to remain on the premises at the conclusion of permitted hours.
8. The licence holder shall ensure, that persons refrain from loitering in the immediate vicinity of the premises.

Food

9. The Licence holder shall allow patrons who have purchased and paid for food prior to the conclusion of permitted hours are allowed to consume any food purchased.
10. All takeaway food containers should be readily identifiable with the premises.

Rubbish

11. A litter patrol must take place at the end of the evening to retrieve any obviously discarded containers associated with the premises.
12. A litter bin to the Council's approved design should be provided to supplement the Council's litter bin provision.

Change of Circumstances

- 13 The licence holder, shall within seven working days, notify the Licensing Authority of any change of circumstances (i.e. change of address; medical conditions; criminal convictions; no longer operating as a late hours caterer etc.). Any licensee in doubt as to what constitutes a change of circumstances should contact the office of Head of Legal and Regulatory Support for guidance.
