Under provisions in the Immigration Act 2014, you should be aware that if you are not a 'relevant national', or do not have appropriate immigration status, or a relevant visa for a marriage/civil partnership in the United Kingdom, your proposed marriage/civil partnership will be referred to the Home Office for investigation.
