PROPOSAL FOR FUNDING CONTRIBUTION TOWARDS A SUMMER EVENTS PROGRAMME 19TH – 27th JULY IN HELENSBURGH TOWN CENTRE.

1. SUMMARY

- 1.1 The Helensburgh and Lomond Chamber of Commerce are seeking financial support from the Council to run a programme of summer events in the town centre between the 19th 27th July 2014.
- 1.2 Details of the events are outlined in Appendix A along with the level of local sponsorship and in kind support that the Chamber has raised to date (£46,500) to hold the events.

2. RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 That the Helensburgh and Lomond Members approve the funding request of £17,925 from the Helensburgh CHORD Budget to the Helensburgh & Lomond Chamber of Commerce to run summer events in Helensburgh Town Centre as outlined in Appendix A.
- 2.2 That the Helensburgh and Lomond Members instructs the Executive Director of Development and Infrastructure Services to enter into an agreement with the Helensburgh and Lomond Chamber of Commerce to contribute up to a maximum of £17,925 towards the above summer event subject to the Chamber meeting the Council's standard funding terms and conditions.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 The Helensburgh and Lomond Chamber of Commerce has approached the Helensburgh CHORD Project Manager requesting financial support from the Helensburgh CHORD budget of £17,925 to run summer events in the town in a bid to encourage locals and visitors to come into the town centre and as well as enjoy the events hopefully boost local trade.
- 3.2 The above funds are required to promote and market the event e.g. flags, bunting, printing of competition forms, poster and flyers etc. and to contribute towards the running of the following events "Visit the Commonwealth in Helensburgh"; "Roller Magic"; "BBQ in the Square"; "Music Festival"; Food Festival, Craft Fair; etc. see Appendix A for event details
- 3.3 Details of the organisations who have agreed to support the event through both direct financial support and in kind are also outlined in Appendix A. The total level of financial support received to date is £46.500.

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- 3.4 The above event is part of the Chambers wider ambition to develop a year round tourism-focused events and promotion programme to augment the very successful Winter Festivals.
- 3.5 The proposal has the support of the both the Helensburgh Community Council and Visit Helensburgh, with the latter directly supporting the event.

4. CONCLUSION

- 4.1 Due to the nature and scale of the CHORD town centre public realm works, traders are reporting a downturn in trade despite efforts to minimise disruption as much as possible. However, it is encouraging that Traders in West Clyde Street (completed phase 1a works) are already reporting an upturn in trade. Therefore to help support local businesses in the town centre during the CHORD works and to demonstrate the long term benefits of the works to users and visitors to the town, providing financial support to hold the summer events is deemed an appropriate use of the CHORD budget.
- 4.2 The Helensburgh CHORD Project Manager has recently reviewed the budget and can confirm that funds are available to support this event.
- 4.3 In the event that works to Colquhoun Square are not completed in time to host the planned events, the organisers have put a contingency plan in place, outlined in Appendix A
