At the second calling of the above Review, Members agreed to admit new evidence into the process in the form of 18 proforma letters of support from individuals who had not previously made a representation to the original planning application.

Members have afforded all parties the opportunity to comment on the submission. The following is Officers response to the points set out in the proforma letters.

- In respect of paragraph one, Officers agree that growth and retention of population, particularly in the islands, is aligned with overarching, strategic objectives of the Council.
- Paragraph two intimates that the use of the proposed building may be intended for a purpose other than agriculture as it is indicated that it is to be used by a person who is a "qualified Engineer", with the building being required to "keep under cover the various machinery associated with the business". In the context of this statement it is unclear whether the "business" referred to is the existing agricultural holding that the application site relates to or another unspecified commercial operation that is intended to be undertaken within the building. It is however noted that the planning application currently under consideration by the LRB is described as an "agricultural building", the intended use of the building for any purpose other than agriculture would give rise to a material change of use that would require planning permission in its own right as a separate matter and as such, if this were the case, would not be a material consideration that should be afforded weighting in the LRB's deliberation of this application.
- In respect of paragraph three, Officers note this statement but would also observe that it is unclear whether the reference is made to agricultural equipment or to equipment required for another commercial purpose as may have been intimated above.

The Officers have no further comments to make on the submission.

REFUSAL OF PLANNING PERMISSION 21/02149/PP FOR THE RETROSPECTIVE ERECTION OF AGRICULTURAL BUILDING THE CAMP, CROSSAPOL, ISLE OF TIREE

We agree with the support given in the proforma letters, submitted to the planning office and review board, regarding the importance to retain the resident population and encourage new young people and families to the island. However, this review is not about the strategic objectives of the council but about the construction of a very large steel framed agricultural building that will do little for either of the above.



Throughout this process we have maintained no objection to a replacement of the previous building, which was demolished by the applicant. Our concerns remain the same about the sheer scale, especially the height which will significantly reduce the level of light into our properties, and the proposed long-term use of the building and whether the materials used for its construction are fit for purpose.

At the first calling of the above Review, Members have requested additional information and clarification from planning officers. The following is our response to the matters raised:

- In respect of matter A, officers must respectfully point out that no additional information or clarification has been received from the Agent in respect of the request for the submission of a supporting statement/written statement confirming the exact use of the agricultural shed which planning permission was sought for. The information provided by the Agent in his email of the 9th July 2022 merely repeats the information already available to officers and Members.
- In respect of matter B, officers are of the opinion that the previous planning permission (reference 20/00273/PP) is capable of being legally revoked by the applicant should Members so require it to be.

Further to the response from the applicant's agent received 01/08/2022

As the listed machines and agricultural implements are lying about the two crofts why is an agricultural shed not being built on the croft, closer to the applicants home, rather than on a commercial site?

If the intended purpose of the shed is now to solely store agricultural machinery, why does the building need to be so high? 5.050m plus roof space (over 16.5 feet to eaves height) None of the machinery shown in the photographs require a building of this height.

As it is noted that a shed or sheds is urgently required, why has no start been made on the agricultural building which had planning permission granted in April 2020, to which we raised no concerns due to its siting having little or no impact on our properties?

LOCAL REVIEW BODY REF: 22/0002/LRB - RESPONSE TO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FROM ARGYLL & BUTE COUNCIL PLANNING DEPARTMENT

I cannot understand the comment that the Agent repeats the information already available to the Council and Review Panel. The information was repeated because that is the exact use the agricultural shed will be used for.

The reasons requesting a Review stated on Page 2 Paragraph 2 "documents 3 are photographs of various agricultural implements which are lying about the two crofts. They include three tractors, baler, mower, baler wrapper, trailer, excavator etc. Therefore as there are no suitable sheds on the crofts that can accommodate the agricultural equipment a new shed or sheds is a necessity."

Does that not explain what the shed is going to be used for? The photographs also show the equipment lying outside exposed to the wind and rain. Machinery has to be kept dry and in good condition. The members of the Review Panel, if they attend a site inspection, will see the equipment exposed to the elements.

I again referred to the use of the shed in my comments to the Statement of Case by Argyll & Bute Council. Page 1.

Again I wish to state that I cannot understand why Argyll & Bute Planning Department does not appear to have read the submission and looked at the photographs which show the equipment to be housed in the shed.

There are no suitable buildings on the crofts to keep the agricultural equipment. Therefore a shed or sheds is urgently required.
