## **SCHOOL HOLIDAYS 2017-18**

## 1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 1.1 The major school holiday arrangements for Argyll and Bute for session 2017/2018 require to be set by the Council.
- Members are asked to agree a framework for the main school holiday periods in Argyll and Bute that will enable Education Services to align the in-service days for teachers and the holiday dates for pupils. Aligning the in-service days for teachers will improve school collaboration, delivery of continuing professional development courses and the sharing of good practice. In addition these arrangements provide enhanced opportunities for staff to come together to work on key improvement activities arising from the new Education Act and National Improvement Framework (NIF)
- 1.3 Prior to submitting this proposal full consultation took place with Parent Councils for school holiday arrangements for 2017/2018. Head Teachers were informed of this consultation. The consultation documents and summary outcomes at this stage of the consultation is contained in Appendix 1.
- 1.4 Proposals for the main school holiday periods in Argyll and Bute is attached as Appendix 2. They take appropriate account of the Parent Council consultation and arrangements outlined by other authorities.

## 2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 Community Services Committee is asked to:
  - a) Note the approach being taken to consult on the proposed arrangements for school holiday in session 2017/2018;
  - Note that further consultation with appropriate Unions on the proposal for school holiday arrangements in Session 2017/2018 will be taken forward, and

#### **SCHOOL HOLIDAYS 2017-18**

#### 3.0 INTRODUCTION

- 3.1 The major school holiday arrangements for Argyll and Bute for session 2017/2018 require to be set by the Council.
- 3.2 Members are asked to agree a framework for the main school holiday periods in Argyll and Bute that will enable Education Services to align the in-service days for teachers and the holiday dates for pupils. Aligning the in-service days for teachers will improve school collaboration, delivery of continuing professional development courses and the sharing of good practice. In addition these arrangements provide enhanced opportunities for staff to come together to work on key improvement activities arising from the new Education Act and National Improvement Framework (NIF)
- 3.3 Prior to submitting this proposal full consultation took place with Parent Councils for school holiday arrangements for 2017/2018. Head Teachers were informed of this consultation. The consultation documents and summary outcomes at this stage of the consultation is contained in Appendix 1.
- 3.4 Proposals for the main school holiday periods in Argyll and Bute is attached as Appendix 2. They take appropriate account of the Parent Council consultation and arrangements outlined by other authorities.

#### 4.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 4.1 Community Services Committee is asked to:
  - a) Note the approach being taken to consult on the proposed arrangements for school holiday in session 2017/2018;
  - Note that further consultation with appropriate Unions on the proposal for school holiday arrangements in Session 2017/2018 will be taken forward, and
  - c) Agree that the final pattern of school holidays and in-service days are

presented for consideration at the September Community Services Committee meeting.

## 5.0 DETAIL

- 5.1 There is no requirement under Schedule 1 of the Schools (Consultation) (Scotland) Act 2010, 2000 to consult on and give notice in respect of school holidays. However, prior to submitting this proposal full consultation took place with Parent Councils for school holiday arrangements for 2017/2018 with all Parent Council Chairs receiving a copy of the proposal or circulation and discussion with their members. Head Teachers were informed of this consultation by e-mail with a copy of the proposal attached. Fifty-nine of the eighty-three Parent Council's responded to the consultation. The school holiday proposal in Appendix 2 reflects the majority outcome of this consultation and includes the views of late respondents.
- 5.2 Copies of the school holiday proposals have been circulated to the relevant unions and teachers' professional associations for consultation and comment.
- 5.3 Following this, a final consultation taking account of the comments of all consulted parties will take place with Parent Councils to set the school holiday arrangements for 2017/18. Head Teachers will be informed of this final consultation by e-mail with a copy of the proposal attached.
- 5.4 The completed school holiday arrangements will then be intimated to all members and thereafter to all relevant parties.

## 6.0 CONCLUSION

6.1 The Parent Council consultation has resulted in a proposed school holiday pattern which minimises variation between local areas within Argyll and Bute yet broadly takes account of historical school holiday arrangements.
