- The Association's Investment Programme 2016/17 in Oban, Lorn and the Isles(continued)
- Door entry packages; Lorn 16 closes
- Contract for 81 elements, mostly external wall insulation, and 6 owner related elements completed in June 16.
- 52 Soroba Road, Oban completed May 2016. 4 ACHA owned and 2 privately owned flats received a new roof, external wall insulation including facias, soffits, guttering and downpipes.



The Association's Investment Programme 2016/17(continued)

- Small continuing programme of completions for kitchen and bathroom renewal
- Heating, rewire, window and door completions in the remaining properties requiring it



# Reactive repairs and cyclical maintenance 2015/16

- £1.3million invested in reactive repairs and cyclical maintenance
- Gas servicing, solid fuel servicing, electrical servicing, legionella testing, lift servicing, close and external painterwork



#### Employment dividend

- 24 ACHA employees in Oban
- 14 AHFA employees in Oban
- 70 tradesmen on average on ACHA new build projects in the Oban and Lorn area
- Significant sub contractor contracting
- Materials purchases Travis Perkins



Building new homes

- Glenshellach, Oban Phase 8 17 properties, phased handover from November 2016 to February 2017
- Connel Phase 2 –Powell Place 10 properties completed in November 2016. Official opening held on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2016.
- Bowmore, Islay Phase 2 10 properties completed in November 2016. Official opening held on 18<sup>th</sup> November 2016

Building new homes – Forward Programme

- Coll Planning approval received for 2 properties on site December 2016
- Connel Ph 3 –10 units on site October 2016
- Glenshellach Ph 10 8 units on site August 2016
- Bowmore, Islay Ph 3 20 units on site October 2016
- Glenshellach Ph 11 and 12 planning approval for 42 properties
- Glenshellach planning submission for a further 6 homes



### Building new homes – Forward Programme

- Kilmore planning application for 8 homes
- North Connel application for 1 home
- Evaluating sites for a further 30 units in Oban
- Working with North Argyll Carers Centre to design
  properties for specific needs



#### **Other Updates**

- Right to Buy ended 31<sup>st</sup> July 2016. 91 applications received since 1<sup>st</sup> April. The last three years; 86, 60 and 61.
- Continuing work with the Council to house Syrian refugees
- Private finance facility £13million with Lloyds Banking Group
- ACHA plans to build 220 new homes over the next four years.



Other Updates (continued)

- Energy Efficiency Standard for Social Housing by 2020; 75% complete.
- European Social Fund application with Argyll and Bute Council
- The Association has agreed to continue facilitating our Welfare Rights Service for the next three years.
