ROADS REVENUE BUDGET AND ROADS ACTIVITIES 2016/17 – 2nd Quarter Update

1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to advise Members of the roads revenue budget position at the end of the 2nd Quarter of financial year 2016/17. It also provides a commentary of the main operational activities undertaken in the quarter.

2016/17 Budget - The overall roads maintenance budget for the 2016/17 year (excluding winter maintenance and coastal protection) is \pounds 3,972,055. The roads maintenance budget for the 2016/17 year (excluding winter maintenance, coastal protection and centrally allocated budgets) for the Oban, Lorn and the Isles area, is \pounds 1,108,900. A Roads Revenue spend of £555,518 has been reported at the end of the 2nd Quarter – or 50%.

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2.0 SUMMARY

2.1 This report follows-on from the reports presented at earlier Committees, which provided information on road maintenance revenue budget and activities being delivered.

3.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

3.1 That the Committee notes this report.

4.0 DETAILS

The Roads Operations Budget is proposed in line with the Roads Maintenance and Management Strategy and the Roads Maintenance and Asset Management Plan (RAMP).

Roads revenue expenditure is closely monitored by separating types of work into different 'activities'. This report is based solely upon financial information which has been collated through the 'Total' costing system. Budgetary figures provided in the Appendices to this report represent spends to the end of Q2 for the 2016/17 financial year. Winter maintenance and coastal protection costs have been excluded from this report.

Appendix 1 provides information on percentage spend at the end of Q2 for 2016/17 for each area – The Oban, Lorn and the Isles area is highlighted in yellow

Appendix 2 shows spend at the end of Q2 for all activities in the Oban, Lorn and the Isles area this financial year 2016/17.

5.0 OPERATIONAL ACTIVITIES THIS QUARTER

Capital

Capital schemes were nearly all completed in this quarter. There is some lining work outstanding across the area, this is being addressed as weather conditions allow.

A819 Ladyfield – overlay in progress due for completion 26th November.

U71 Fidden Road from A849 Junction to farm S bends – overlay complete.

C48 Carsaig – overlay of existing surface complete.

U16 Croggan road from C54 junction to Croggan – overlay complete.

<u>Revenue</u>

Schedules of works are assembled from information gathered from safety inspections, reported defects together with cyclic works such as verge cutting, gully cleansing, ditching etc.

In OLI the following work was completed, this is not exhaustive but gives an idea of the breadth of work completed:

- Embankment repair at B840 Portsonachan
- Embankment repair at Port Appin
- Extensive jet patching and other road repair work over a 12 week period in Mull across the whole island.
- Full cycle of grass cutting, plus additional secondary wider cuts for sightlines e.g. A819, achieved within the budget.

In addition to the above works, repairs have been carried out to defects identified from safety inspections, reported defects etc. These works have been carried out to ensure that the road network is safe for the travelling public.

6.0 CONCLUSIONS

This report provides Members with a financial update on the roads revenue maintenance budget for the Oban, Lorn and the Isles area at the end of Q2 2016/17.

It indicates that 50% or £555,518 of the roads maintenance revenue budget has been spent.

Further quarterly reports will continue to be presented to Members at future Area Committees.
