No additional comments to make.

Reasons for conditions and why they should remain.

- 1. The access should have been constructed as per the Councils standard detail, prior to any work starting on site.
- 2. The visibility splays should have been cleared prior to any work starting on site.
- 3. The access to be constructed as per the Councils standard detail drawing as the access will be used by maintenance vehicles, access for a crane may be required. Large vehicles using a sub-standard access will cause damage to the road verge.
- 4. The visibility splays should be cleared in the interest of road safety. There is an intensification of use of this access, road safety should never be compromised.
- 5. The applicant should report fly tipping to Roads & Amenity Services.

I was disappointed to learn that the access was not constructed as per the standard detail drawing or the sightlines cleared as stated in the planning conditions. Roads & Amenity Services apply these conditions to safeguard the public and to reduce possible to road verges.
