**DETAILS OF VARIATIONS SOUGHT:-**

The applicant wishes to vary the licence as follows:-

- 1) To add off-sales to the licence (see above)
- 2) To amend the core hours for on-sales (see above)
- 3) To add the following wording at Question 5(f) Any other activities:- A partly consumed bottle of wine may be taken as off-sales after a meal giving customers more control over their consumption. This would cover wine purchased with a meal only. No other off-sales will be offered.

**CURRENT ACTIVITIES:** Restaurant facilities; Receptions including weddings, funerals etc; recorded music.

**LSO:** This is an application for a major variation to the operating plan to amend the hours for the sale of alcohol. The applicant has liaised with the LSO during this application and there are no concerns.

Operating Plan - Proposed updates as follows:

Question 1 – Statement of Core Hours - there will be both on and off sales of alcohol

Question 2 – On Sales Hours - 1200 hours to 2300 hours (Mon-Sat) and 1700 hours to 2300 hours (Sun)

Question 3 – Off Sales Hours - 1200 hours to 2200 hours (Mon-Sat) and 1700 hours to 2200 hours (Sun)

Question 5(f) - add: *“A partly consumed bottle of wine may be taken as off sales after a meal giving customers more control over their consumption. This would cover wine purchased with a meal only. No other off sales will be offered.”*

There are no other changes to the operating plan,

**POINTS FOR CONSIDERATION:-**

- (1) Addition of off-sales hours
- (2) Amendment of on-sales hours - commencement of hours put back from 11am to midday Monday to Saturday and from 12.30pm to 5pm on a Sunday. Terminal hour on a Sunday extended from 10pm to 11pm.
- (3) Off-sales provision only being sought to enable customers to take away a partly consumed bottle of wine.
