REPORT FOR YEAR TO 31<sup>st</sup> MARCH 2018.


This report of the activities of the Cruach Mhor Wind Farm Trust for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018 is for submission to the Bute and Cowal area Committee of the Argyll and Bute Council.

At the end of year the Trustees in office were Councillor Alex McNaughton the elected member and Chairman; Danuta Steedman and Tom Mowat locally elected members of the Community Council for Colintrave and Glendaruel and nominated members representing these areas on the wind farm trust, and Gillian Arnot representative of Scottish Power.

The Annual grant from Scottish Power for the year had been £31,715.95 and the Royal Bank of Scotland had refunded Bank charges of £650.77. During the year Grants had been awarded totalling £23,071.66 of which those for the benefit of children totalled £7417.51. At the end of the financial year further Applications awaiting approval, had been made totalling about £9,500. Cheques issued for approved grants at the end the year, still to be cleared through the bank, were £6418,40.

The attached statement of account has been examined by an independent person.

April 2017 Renovation of road surface at the Crescent, Glendaruel which would be shared by all eight proprietors. Problems Have arisen among the owners regarding shared costs, local authority Interests, future management etc. The extent of the work and the cost have Not yet been settled. Cost could be between £1 and £2K. in total.

May 2017 River Ruel improvement. This could cost £2-3K per annum For 10 to 20 years. It is worth doing but needs more enthusiasm in The Glen. Some work was done on the river bank but nothing else may Happen.

April 2018 The Gardens at the Colintrave Hall are in need of serious Attention. Initial work has been done and much more is planned. Cost around £5k likely. Ros McKenna, chair of hall committee Will be in touch when they are ready to proceed. The gardens were Established by local effort and fundraising about 12 years ago and are Popular with locals and vistors alike

March 2018 Shinty Club wants to encourage primary school children, to improve Facilities and equipment . Will give more information ASAP.

March 2018 Arts Recreation Club is a Children's summer school project which has Been supported for over ten years. It is popular with local children and Those on holiday in the district. This is a well run activity of benefit to the Area. Grant asked for is £2500.
