**SECTION 84A, LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005
NOTICE OF HEARING
PERSONAL LICENCE NUMBER: AR/2160**

I am writing to advise that, in terms of Section 84A (1) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, the Licensing Board has received a report from the Chief Constable stating that you have acted in a manner which is inconsistent with the following licensing objectives:-

- Preventing crime & disorder, and
- Protecting & Improving Public Health

This report is based on the information contained in the attached letter dated 10th April 2018.

Where the Licensing Board is in receipt of such a report then it must hold a hearing. Accordingly, I am writing to advise that a hearing will take place before the Licensing Board to consider this matter within the Council Chambers, Kilmory, Lochgilphead, PA31 8RT on 26th June 2018 at 11.30am or as soon thereafter as other business allows. You may appear personally at the hearing and/or be represented. If you choose to appear then you and/or your representative will be given the opportunity to be heard by the Board.

You should be aware that, after giving you and the Chief Constable an opportunity to be heard and if satisfied that it is necessary to do so for the purposes of any of the licensing objectives, then the Licensing Board may make an order revoking, suspending or endorsing your licence.

Clearly this matter has potentially serious consequences for you as a personal licence holder and if you have not already done so, you should consider taking legal advice.
