DESCRIPTION OF PREMISES:

End of terrace 2 storey building located on Argyll Street in the town centre, with public house on the ground floor and a lounge bar on the first floor.

The public house consists of a public bar with a games area, ladies and gents toilet, cellar, prep kitchen, office and storage on the ground floor. On the first floor there is a lounge bar, ladies and gents toilets, kitchen and storage. Outside there is an external licensed terrace. The Public House sells alcohol, both on and off premises, hot and cold beverages and hot and cold bar food.

DETAILS OF VARIATIONS SOUGHT:-

The applicants wish to vary the licence as follows:-

- 1) To amend the terminal hour to 2am Thursday to Saturday.
- 2) Addition of dance facilities and restaurant as activities on the licence.

CURRENT ACTIVITIES:- Bar meals; Receptions including weddings, birthdays; Club or other group meetings; Recorded music; Live performances; Gaming; Indoor/Outdoor sports; Televised sport; Outdoor drinking facilities; Adult entertainment.

LSO:- The Premises Licence Holder is Green King Ltd and is leased to the current Designated Premises Manager. The LSO had discussion with management with regard to changes made to upgrade the internal decoration and to a change in direction as to the current operating model to suit the current late night economy in Dunoon town centre.

"Licensed hours for on-sales premises in particular can have an impact not only within the individual premises but also within the locality in which the premises are situated. Taking into account the five licensing objectives, the presumption against 24 hour drinking and the guidance for Licensing Boards and Local Authorities issued by the Scottish Executive and that mandatory conditions specified by Regulation

ITEM 6(g)

apply to those premises opening after 1 am, the Board considers the following to be appropriate for the terminal hour beyond which alcohol must not be sold on the premises or parts of the premises:-

Sunday to Thursday - 12 midnight and Friday & Saturday - 1.00am

Applications for hours at times out with the Board's Policy will require demonstrate that the additional requested hours are appropriate in the circumstances."
