I have to inform you that the Chief Constable wishes to make the following representation in relation to the above application.

In relation to the proposal for outdoor drinking and eating facilities on the grassed area adjacent to the premises on the Lochside, the Chief Constable would request that some form of delineation be provided by the applicant to ensure that their seating area is clearly defined, and to prevent patrons having ready access to the loch.

Further, the Chief Constable has concerns regarding customers accessing the new outdoor area from the premises. There is an area to the front of the premises which is used as a road and would also appear to be used for parking. Customers would have to cross this area to get to the seated area so it would be suggested that any alcohol being taken to the external area, would be delivered by staff.

Further, it would be suggested that some form of signage be used on the roads in each directions to highlight to drivers that patrons may be crossing the road at this location.
