

### **Water Main – Campbeltown to Machrihanish**

Scottish Water are aware of bursts on this stretch of water main and I can confirm this has been promoted for investment and allocated funding. This is currently being developed through our engineering design process. At this stage we cannot advise on start on site however I will provide an update as this is developed further.

### **Meadowburn, Campbeltown - Odours**

Scottish Water plans to re-introduce chemical dosing as odour reduction measure at Meadowburn, Campbeltown. The required refurbishment of the chemical dosing unit has now been complete and we would look to be in a position to commence with the dosing in the coming weeks. I will send an update to confirm this is in place.

### **Tarbert – Sewer Flooding Project**

As previously confirmed Scottish water has now passed this project to our alliance delivery partner, Amey Black and Veatch (AVB) to carry out detailed design. There are several important factor to consider including the potential impact on roads and the community and there will be requirement for further engagement with the Roads Dept and Bear Scotland. Site investigation works will commence on the 24<sup>th</sup> of September for a period of 4 weeks and these investigations will inform final design. Importantly whilst we work to delivery this project in Tarbert we have put in place temporary measure which should reduce the flood risk over the interim period. We have agreed to meet with the community council in September and will continue to keep elected members and the community up to date.
