- 1.1 The Council's current Chief Executive tendered his resignation on 23rd September 2019. A recruitment exercise was undertaken and a high number of quality applications were received. The Appointments Panel of 7 members met on 22nd November to carry out a competitive interview process and take a decision on making an appointment.
- 1.2 Pippa Milne, currently one of the Council's Executive Directors, was duly appointed.
