The refits of the other vessels should take place when the Coruisk is available to substitute for them.

This route has a large number of weather related cancelled sailings, especially during winter. Putting the Coruisk on the route when it is available would reduce the number of cancellations.

The same applies to refits. The Coruisk should be used to cover for the vessel away for refit.
