PROPOSED DESCRIPTION OF PREMISES: The premises consists of a dining room, a post office and shop counter with a small bar serving area, a shopping area, storage, toilets, baby changing, rear

garden and cafe seating outside at the front of the building.

CURRENT ACTIVITIES ON THE LICENCE: Accommodation; Conference facilities; Restaurant facilities; Bar meals; Receptions; Funerals; Club or other group meetings; Recorded music; Live performances;

Dance facilities; Indoor/Outdoor sports; Televised sport and outdoor drinking facilities.

CURRENT CHILDREN AND YOUNG PERSON'S CONDITIONS:

TERMS – Children and young persons will be permitted provided they are accompanied by an adult and display acceptable behaviour.

AGES – 0-15 years – Children; 16-17 years - Young Persons

TIMES – In line with our family friendly policy, children, accompanied by an adult, eating a meal at the Inn, will be permitted up to 22.00. Young persons, accompanied by an adult, will be permitted up to 23.00.

PARTS - Children and young persons will be permitted access to the hallway, lounge/restaurant, toilets, enclosed garden and games room. Accompanied by an adult, children and young persons will be permitted access to the public bar with the exclusion of the bar counter.

PROPOSED CHILDREN AND YOUNG PERSON'S CONDITIONS:

TERMS – Where alcohol is being consumed, children and young persons will be permitted provided they are accompanied by an adult and display acceptable behaviour.

AGES – 0-15 years – Children; 16-17 years - Young Persons

TIMES – In line with our family friendly policy, children and young persons will be allowed entry into the premises during normal shop and post office opening hours. When eating a meal, accompanied by an adult, children will be permitted up to 10.00pm.

PARTS - Children and young persons will be permitted access to the hallway, dining area, shop and post office area, groceries area, toilets, enclosed rear garden and cafe seating at the front of the premises. Children and young persons will be excluded from the bar counter area.
