



Argyll and Bute Biodiversity Duty Document Chart:

Argyll and Bute Council- Biodiversity Duty as a public body.

The Biodiversity Duty is set out in the Nature Conservation (Scotland) Act 2004.

Following an amendment in the Wildlife and Natural Environment (Scotland) Act 2011; every three years public bodies are required to publish and make publically available their compliance report on the actions they have taken to meet their biodiversity duty.

Role: to inform the Scottish Government Biodiversity Duty Compliance Report, the current plan is due to be refreshed in 2021

Scottish Government Biodiversity Duty Compliance Report
