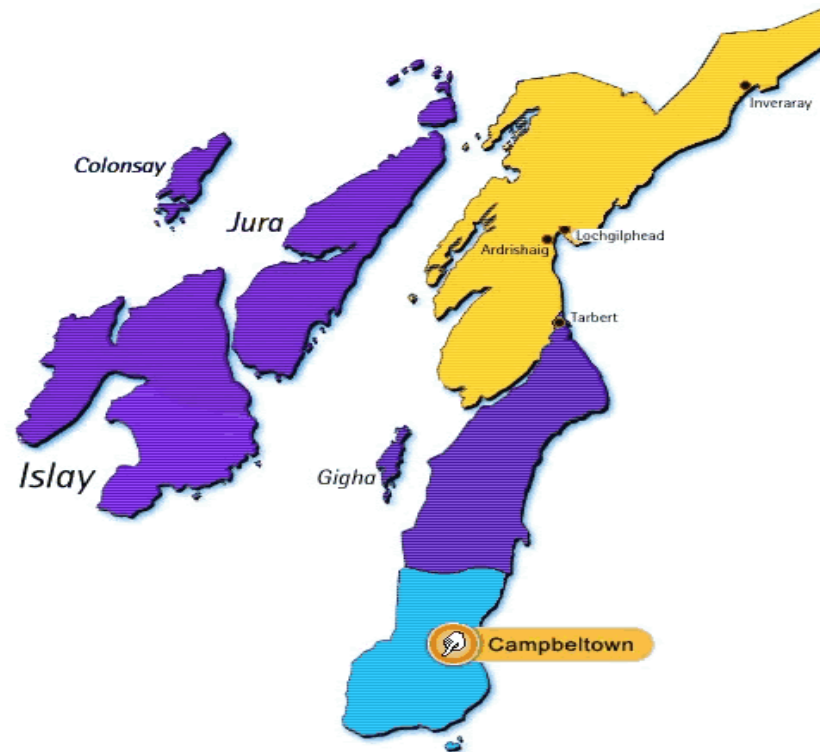

- Post Domestic Incident Response (PDIR) – 4
