I am currently a resident of the top floor of the building which houses the new brewery. I am opposed to the proposed hours for the following reasons.

The brewery is going to cause disruption for the residents of the building and also those of nearby properties due to the deliveries, noise and smells that the brewery will be producing/needing. In my opinion, there is no need to add to those disruptions by keeping it open until 10pm every day of the week.

Currently, the only shop open in Tobermory until 10pm is the Co-op which provides essential services to the island. A brewery does not.
