Campbeltown CC Report for MAKI

The CC's charitable organization, Campbeltown Community Windfarm Fund has disbursed approximately £47,000 to 17 local organisations and social enterprises in line with the priorities identified in our Action Plan.

The disabled swing and the access for wheelchair users at Jock's Boat playpark are now complete.

While the workers have made a good job of repairing the sea defences at the Esplanade. It is only 80% completed. There are still areas in need of repair and still at least 3 holes in the sea wall.

Town Centre traffic – the CC have agreed that the current traffic management system along Longrow and Burnbank Street is not working and propose one way system for whole length of Longrow, stopping flow of traffic down Burnbank. The CC has also identified a need to look at one-way roads in the housing scheme at Ralston Rd, Crosshill Ave and Meadows Ave.

We are still awaiting the resurfacing of the Esplanade.

The CC is worried about the continued deterioration of the two empty buildings in the Main Street, namely the White Hart Hotel and the Old Post Office Building. These are both infested with pigeons and are becoming a health hazard and a danger to the public.

The SUStrans sculpture at the new quay has been surrounded by wire fencing for some time now. When will this be removed?
