



Outcomes Improvement Plan

Reviewing priorities

An **Outcomes Improvement Plan** includes:



- Local **outcomes to which priority has to be given by the CPP** with a view to improving the achievement of the outcomes
- **Description of the proposed improvement** in the achievement of the outcomes
- **Period of time** in which the proposed improvement is to be achieved
- Description of the **needs and circumstances of persons residing** in the area

(Community Planning: Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015)

The legislation requires that we:



Understand and set out the needs and circumstances of those people living in Argyll and Bute

(reviewed in July – September 2022)

Understand and agree what the priority outcomes are for Argyll and Bute

(going out to consult October – December 2022)

Describe what improvements are to be achieved for these priority outcomes

(focus groups 2023)

Understand and set out the needs and circumstances of people living in Argyll and Bute



- ✓ Review of data on population needs and circumstances
- ✓ Review of previous engagement and consultations
- ✓ Review of community planning partners strategic plans

Next steps:



Consult to identify the top 3 priority themes (*October – December 2022*)

- Survey with population and CPP partners (ranking top 3 priority themes)
- Survey with CPP (level of partnership working on themes)

Top tips for a review



- Keep surveys short and ideally via Instagram for young people
- Don't ask people in communities what they have been asked before
- Create a toolkit/ information sheets that partners can use to support engagement around the review
- Ask CPP partners what they think priorities are

Future steps



- **7 December 2022 CPP meeting:** Present interim findings from consultation on priorities
- **Jan – Feb 2023:** Focus groups on priority themes identified
- **March 2023 CPP meeting** – Agree priority themes for 10-year plan and state general improvements to be achieved by the CPP on these
- **From March 2023**
 - Agree actions
 - Agree governance to deliver and monitor actions
 - Publish plan (2024-2034)
 - Start working with ACPGs to identify local area priorities and actions
