The Scottish Government has adopted a community wealth building approach as a key practical means to achieve wellbeing economy objectives outlined in the National Strategy for Economic Transformation (NSET), and many areas and communities, across Scotland are advancing the agenda.

No prior knowledge of CWB is required. It will all be explained on the day, with ample time for your own input to help shape this agenda moving forward and advance your own work.

### Argyll and Bute Community Directory

The A&B TSI database contains over 1400 services across the region and has powered the **Argyll and Bute Community Directory** which launched on 6<sup>th</sup> September 2022 (<a href="https://abcd.scot/">https://abcd.scot/</a>). The directory provides a referral route for third sector services (and some statutory services) and it provides a means to analyse the strengths and gaps in local provision as well as map this against data such as that on poverty, health inequality and demographics.
