

Forestry and Land Scotland (FLS) update January 2024

Land Management Plans (LMPs)

South Knapdale

Site surveys and scoping underway.

East Loch Awe

Undergoing mid-term review (5 years).

Larch- Phytophthora ramorum

The disease is still spreading throughout Kintyre with infected areas now in the Kilberry area and as far north as West Loch Awe. Infections in East Loch Awe, Kilmichael and Knapdale.

Challenges with Statutory Plant Health Notice (SPHNs) in terms of visual impacts and potential impacts on flood risks/extreme rainfall events.

Active felling programmed starting spring 2024 for removing larch throughout West Loch Awe.

Peatland restoration

Completed 41Ha peatland restoration in West Lussa, Drumore Burn.

Started restoration operations on 70Ha site in Lussa, BAT II. Currently working on sediment mitigation to ensure water courses aren't polluted during drain blocking operations. Consultation with SEPA, and planned to take 2-3 months.

Upcoming "complex" operations

Beinn Ghuilean felling

Complex issues resulting in delaying operations until 2025/2026.

Dunardy Face, Knapdale felling

Planning conditions from council resulting in delaying operations until winter 2024.



Other information

- FLS had a stand at Lochgilphead High School careers fair to promote forest industry.
- Active project underway to accurately check and map all private water supplies across the West Region.
- Successful beaver release (4 beavers) in Knapdale forest December 2023.
- Invasive species removal operations at Scotnish underway.
- SSE substation works with potential impacts on the forest road near Achnabreac.
