

Group governance, membership, volunteer retention, funding and facility management continue to be recurrent themes when working with groups and organisations.

Community Development often work in partnership with the TSI, Live Argyll, and other agencies when working with local groups. Recent work includes:

- **Princess Louise Hall** – the group are in the final stages of completing the lease of the PLH and Howie Pavilion with Estates. The group are also working with Community Development to install IT equipment, from the UK Shared Prosperity Fund, to increase its potential future usage by learners and a wider range of community organisations
- **Friends of Hermitage Park** – with assistance from Community Development have held their first park user group meeting attracting 8 representatives from park user groups and individuals.
- **Welcome In Recovery Café** – working with With You, New Way and Community Development the group are being assisted in the organisation of a Family Fun day Saturday October the 12th , to celebrate Recovery from Addictions,
- **Alcohol and Drugs Partnership** – CDOs in Helensburgh (and B&C) leading on Alcohol and Drugs forums to assist in the development of local ROSC (Recovery Orientated System of Care). CDOs looking to make connections between community partners, statutory services and those in active recovery central to the partnership. Engagement stage at present working to explore existing services and relationships. This work is commissioned by the ADP
- **C&K “Our Community”/ Cove Gardening Group / Cove Kilcreggan Youth Café** – Comm Dev and Estates meeting the “Our Community” Development worker, a representative from the gardening and youth group to explore possibility of community growing space Craigrownie Park.
- **Partnership work with Helensburgh Community Hub / Jeans Bothy / Live Argyll** – completion of Health Issues training as professional development.

Discussion with **TSI** – group capacity training to be offered to develop groups’ online presence and engagement skills.

- **Community Engagement** – On-going enquiries including funding, facilities and partnerships .
