## **Local Area Community Plan - Revisions**

#### 1. SUMMARY

1.1 This report responds to the paper titled "Mid Argyll, Kintyre and the Islands Local Area Plan" which details findings and proposals following the Forward Together Community event held in June 2010.

#### 2. RECOMMENDATIONS

- **2.1** That the LACPG agree the proposed amendments to the MAKI Local Area Community Plan
- 2.2 That the LACPG note the intention that the Local Area Community Plan could be better linked to the Single Outcome Agreement and request that further work on this be undertaken.

### 3. BACKGROUND

- **3.1** The report on the findings of the Forward Together 1 event held in June 2010 makes a number of recommendations for revision to the draft MAKI Local Area Community Plan.
- **3.2** Appendix 1 contains a copy of the draft plan. Appendix 2 contains a copy of the revised plan which takes account of the Forward Together 1 event. Rows which comprise of new outcomes or actions are highlighted in green.
- **3.3** With reference to the recommendations made at section 6 of the results from that event it is noted:
  - a) The first two outcomes have been merged to cover the whole MAKI areas
  - Some actions have been taken out where not deemed a priority for the area e.g. use of Police Video Conferencing, or ill defined e.g. Bowmore Town Centre
  - c) Wording has been amended to better reflect the distinction between outcomes, actions and success measures

- d) A new outcome relating to connectivity has been added with actions reflecting priority areas
- e) New actions have been added to reflect some of the key themes of comments made at the Forward Together events
- f) Links with CHORD are more explicit
- g) Feedback will be provided by way of Forward Together 2 event.
- **3.4** It is noted that not all comments made at Forward Together 1 have been reflected within the plan. This is for a number of reasons which include:
  - Not clearly defined
  - Do not establish themselves as a priority
  - Not within remit of LACPG

Where comments may be better suited to other existing partnerships e.g community safety forums, these will be shared with them.

#### 4. CONCLUSION

**4.1** Localised strategic plans of this nature are to be welcomed and links between them and the LACPG, and Area Community Plan should be strengthened.

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
