It was also highlighted to Lomond School by Alastair that bird boxes which were scattered around Duchess Wood may need a bit of attention and it was suggested that the boxes had been supplied by Lomond School. VC will check with the National Park Ranger if this was the case. Eileen to e-mail Gemma and Veronique the photos which Alastair had forwarded to her regarding the work the Friends of Duchess Wood had been involved with some schools.
