Notes for Guidance

- The application should be accompanied by a fee of £250.00 which is charged per raised structure (only applicable to structures over 600mm above adjacent levels) with a separate application for Building Standards Certificate required in each case. Argyll and Bute Council accept the following payment methods:- Debit/Credit Card, Cash or Cheque (payable to Argyll and Bute Council). Debit/Credit Card payments can be made either via our website or by telephoning our customer services number 01546 605518. Application for permission to erect a Raised Structure will not be registered or processed until the appropriate fee has been paid.
- All relevant information regarding the Raised Structure should accompany this application: This should
 include scaled drawings showing the position of the structure on a location plan and details,
 specific to the structure i.e. floor plans, sections, elevations etc. Failure to provide drawings
 sufficient to determine your submission will result in your application and fee being returned to you.
- A Design Certificate for the erection of a Raised Structure should also be provided at this time, completed by the persons, appropriately qualified and authorised to erect/check the structure.
 Note: If calculations are provided which require to be checked an additional charge will be levied.
 On completion of the structure, prior to the event, "A Certificate of Completion of Erection and Inspection of a Raised Structure", should be provided to Building Standards.
- Any person who:-
- (a) uses or permits the use of a Raised Structure for the purpose of providing for themselves or others, raised accommodation without the approval of the Council; or
- (b) Contravenes a condition contained in a notice served on him by the Council.

Shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction, to a fine.

 Application need not be made for the use of any Raised Structure in respect of which a Building Warrant has been granted by Argyll and Bute Council.
