(2) sending a copy of that objection and statement to the IJB and to any officer of the IJB who may be concerned, both at Argyll & Bute Health and Social Care Partnership, Kilmory, Lochgilphead, PA31 8RT.

- (c) Any request which the Integration Joint Board receives in relation to the annual accounts plus any documents provided, will be published on the same websites. When it is not possible to provide a response or information in an electronic format, the request, together with the statement that the authority will not make its response publicly available, will be published in the same place on the website as the inspection notice.

- (d) The auditor shall, if requested by the person objecting, the authority, or by any officer of the authority who may be concerned, afford to that person or authority or officer, as the case may be, an opportunity of appearing before and being heard by the auditor with respect to that objection; and any such person or officer may so appear and be heard either personally or by a representative.
