## **POVERTY AND COST OF LIVING CRISIS**

### **1. Grocers' Charity - Memorial Grants**

Grants up to £5,000 are available to small UK registered charities for work in the specific areas of: relief of youth poverty, the disabled, the elderly, health, military, and the arts and heritage.

### **2. Baillie Gifford Community Fund**

Grants up to £15,000 are available to support grassroots community organisations to address food insecurity and social isolation across Scotland.

### **3. Foundation Scotland - Volant Charitable Trust**

Grants of up to £15,000 per year for up to three years are available for registered charities and other not-for-profit organisations in Scotland undertaking projects to help poverty and social deprivation, particularly supporting children, young people and women.

### **4. NFU Mutual Charitable Trust**

Grants up to £50,000 are available to large charitable groups and organisations in the UK for projects that further the objectives of the NFU Mutual Charitable Trust, particularly those that educate young people in rural areas and the relief of poverty in rural areas.

### **5. Asda Foundation - Cost of Living Grant**

Grants up to £1,600 are available for local community groups in the UK who are affected by the increase in the cost of living. For the current round, the recruitment, retention and training of new volunteers is supported, as well as covering ongoing volunteer-related costs.

### **6. Robertson Trust**

Grants up to £750,000 are available to registered charities in Scotland that are working with communities experiencing poverty and trauma.

### **7. Argyll and Bute Flexible Food and Fuel Fund**

Argyll and Bute Council is continuing to run a fund aimed at tackling financial insecurity for adults and families across Argyll and Bute. The Fund offers financial support and wider confidential professional help to anyone suffering hardship. Working in partnership with the Community Food Forum, Bute Advice Centre and Allenergy, households with low incomes and no access to cash savings can apply for immediate financial support. The Fund will help support daily living expenses. **This fund is for individuals.**

### 8. BBC Children in Need Emergency Essentials Programme

Funding for the purchase of essential items to meet the most basic needs of children and young people in the UK who are facing exceptionally difficult circumstances.

Grants to cover arrears of up to £1,500 will be paid and are available to individuals and families across Great Britain to be used to write off their energy debts.

Grants of up to £10,000 are available to local dog welfare and animal health charities working to support dog owners in the UK in times of personal struggle.

### 11. Corra Foundation – Boost Small Grants

Grants of between £500 and £3,000 are available to support grassroots organisations and charities delivering community-led activities to children and families across Scotland that are struggling due to the cost-of-living crisis.

### 12. COSARAF – Hardship Grants

Grants of up to £2,000 but only in exceptional circumstances will individuals receive a grant of more than £500 these are available for third party social organisations to support individuals and families across the UK who are in financial need and have exhausted all other sources of funding.

### 13. Crowdfunder Cost of Living Crisis Emergency Fund

Projects can get up to £5,000 for their community food project. This fund has been donated by members of the public who want to support community projects through the cost of living crisis. Applications are available to registered UK Charities, registered community benefit organisations and registered social enterprises and charity companies across the UK to tackle food poverty relating to the cost of living crisis.

### 14. Edward Gostling Foundation

Small grants of less than £5,000 are available to support disadvantaged people of all ages who have a physical and/or mental disability or long-term illness, or those on low income.

### 15. Faith in Community Scotland - Greener Spaces, Fairer Places

Grants of up to £500 are available to local faith groups and other related organisations for projects that address poverty and climate change in communities across Scotland.

### 16. Family Action - Welfare Grants Programme

Grants up to £300 are available to support families and individuals for essential personal and household needs to assist families and individuals with low incomes, particularly those living on benefits.

### 17. Family Fund Trust

Grants are available to help families, or groups applying on their behalf, in the UK who are raising a disabled or seriously ill child or young person up to the age of 18 years. Groups in Scotland can apply for help with the higher costs of living. Fund is currently closed to applicants living in Wales and Northern Ireland. Applications are encouraged from Scotland

### 18. Groundwork: One Stop - Community Partnership

Grants of up to £1,000 are available to support not-for-profit organisations who are working to tackle food poverty or supporting the elderly within the local community.

### 19. Hollyhock Charitable Foundation

Grants from £5,000 to £400,000 are available to local not-for-profit groups for projects which bring general benefit to residents and communities across Great Britain, with a focus on health, poverty, education and Christianity.

Grants of between £10,001 and £75,000 are available for voluntary groups, community organisations, and other not-for-profit organisations across Scotland to help support individuals, families, and communities currently experiencing hardship as a result of the cost-of-living crisis.
