## ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (ARGYLL STREET AND CHURCH STREET DUNOON) (SPECIAL EVENT)(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2023

Argyll and Bute Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by The Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994, and of all other powers enabling them to do so, being satisfied that traffic on the lengths of road specified in the Schedules hereto should be prohibited or restricted for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a Christmas Event in Dunoon, and being satisfied that it is not reasonably practical for the event to be held otherwise than on a road, and having had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, with the consent of the Scottish Ministers under Section 16(B)(6)(b) of the said Act hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the "Argyll and Bute Council (Argyll Street and Church Street, Dunoon)(Special Event) (Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2023" and shall be effective when indicated by signs from 0800 hours to 1830 hours on Saturday the 25<sup>th</sup> November 2023.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of the Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Subject to Article 5 of the Order, no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle through the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 4. Subject to Article 5 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait with the exception of taxis, on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 5. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle which is:
  - a) being driven upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform;
  - b) an emergency services vehicle.
  - c) an authorised vehicle associated with the organisation of the event.
- 6. Item 1 in Schedule 7 of The Strathclyde Regional Council (Dunoon Town Centre) (Traffic Management) Order 1996 will be temporarily suspended for the duration of this Order, to permit two-way traffic in Church Street.
