THE ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (B836 BALLIEMORE BRIDGE, LOCH STRIVEN) (TEMPORARY 20MPH SPEED RESTRICTION) ORDER 2023

Argyll and Bute Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), and having complied with the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, hereby make the following Order:

- This Order may be cited as "The Argyll and Bute Council (B836 Balliemore Bridge, Loch Striven)(Temporary 20mph Speed Restriction) Order 2023" and will be effective from 0001 hours on the 11 December 2023 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on the 1 May 2024 or until the works are complete.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20mph, on that length of the B836 Balliemore Bridge, Loch Striven for 260 metres or thereby.
