Argyll and Bute HSCP - Process Map for Conducting an EIA

Decide to conduct EIA

- Is a policy, practice or service being implemented or changed?
- Are the impacts major or minor?
- Will people be affected?
- Engage partners
- Consider who will be affected
- Inform community reps on LPG or IJB
- Engage people with protected characteristics and/or who will be affected
- Source paperwork
- Ensure you use the correct EIA template
- What data do you need for backgound info?
- Do you need to gather new data/intelligence?

Convene working group

- Proportionate input to scale of change
- May be one-off meeting
- Inform members of aims so they are prepared

Conduct EIA

- Systematically consider affected groups
- Record results and feedback

Develop action plan

- What needs to happen to mitigate potential impacts?
- Who needs to do what?

Ratification of EIA

 Completed EIAs to be tabled at Clinical & Care Governance or alternative strategic meeting for quality assurance and Head of Service sign off

Publish EIA

- Publish on Argyll and Bute HSCP website
- Inform key stakeholders of results and actions

Review action plan

- Monitoring and evaluation of the action plan to ensure actions completed
- Consider timescale for reviewing/repeating EIA

Report & feedback outcomes

- Look at the data, are the expected impacts seen or not seen
- Understand the data has EIA has made a difference or is more work needed?
