ORDER 202\_**

Argyll and Bute Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ('the Act'), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, and having complied with Part II of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1999, hereby make the following Order:

- 1 This Order may be cited as "The Argyll and Bute Council (Craighouse, Jura) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 202\_" and shall come into operation on the [date].
  
- 2 No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 mph on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

**SCHEDULE 1**

**30MPH SPEED LIMIT**

Length of Road in Craighouse, Jura, Argyll and Bute

1. That length of the A846 from a point 93 metres southwest of the extended southern kerblineline of Otter Brae extending in a northerly direction for 2,161 metres or thereby.
2. That length of the A846 Branch Road to Craighouse Pier extending from its junction with the A846 Craighouse Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 280 metres or thereby to its termination at Craighouse Pier.
3. The length of the U58 Keills Road from its junction with the A846, extending in a north-westerly direction to the north bank of the Abhuinn nan Caorach, opposite the township of Keills, a distance of 400 metres of thereby.
4. That length of the U78 Croft Park from its junction with the A846, extending in a westerly direction and then in a generally south westerly direction for a distance of 135 metres or thereby.
