## THE ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (CRAIGHOUSE, JURA) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202\_



Argyll and Bute Council proposes to make a Traffic Regulation Order to introduce a 30mph speed restriction on the following length of roads:

- 1. That length of the A846 from a point 93 metres southwest of the extended southern kerbline of Otter Brae extending in a northerly direction for 2,161 metres or thereby.
- 2. That length of the A846 Branch Road to Craighouse Pier extending from its junction with the A846 Craighouse Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 280 metres or thereby to its termination at Craighouse Pier.
- 3. The length of the U58 Keills Road from its junction with the A846, extending in a north-westerly direction to the north bank of the Abhuinn nan Caorach, opposite the township of Keills, a distance of 400 metres of thereby.
- 4. That length of the U78 Croft Park from its junction with the A846, extending in a westerly direction and then in a generally south westerly direction for a distance of 135 metres or thereby.
