ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (A817 GLEN FRUIN ROAD) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024



On Thursday 14 March 2024, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will make it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on that length of the west bound Layby of A817 Glen Fruin Road (Haul Road), Helensburgh, 560m south east of its junction with A814 a layby extending in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 100m metres or thereby.

The restrictions, which are required because essential maintenance works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the length of road, will be in operation between 0600 on the Fourth day of April 2024 to 1800 on the nineteenth day April 2024, or until the works are complete, whichever is the earliest but will only have effect in relation to part or parts of the length of road when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.

Alternative routes will be signed in an appropriate manner.
