A – CalMac connection (Port Askaig departure only) to be booked by noon previous day in advance by calling ferry office on 01496 840681.

B – Bookable late sailing Monday to Saturday. To be booked by noon 1 (one) day in advance by calling the ferry office on 01496 840681. No late sailing can be booked if 0615 has been booked prior.

- It is advisable for passengers to be in attendance on the pier <u>10</u> minutes prior to sailing time for crew to organise boarding and conduct safety announcements. <u>The vessel has a quick turnaround at Feolin, please ensure you arrive at Feolin before the vessel's departure time from Port Askaig.</u>
- <u>Text alert service</u> for delays and cancellations.
- The vessel will attempt to take dangerous goods vehicles between scheduled sailings.
- Double runs will only be made at the Master's discretion, when the vessel can return to Port Askaig in time for the next scheduled departure time.
- <u>Tickets can be purchased online</u> or via the Jura Ferry APP or payment can be made to the deckhand by card, cheque, or cash.
- Calmac RET Scheme not available on this sailing.
- Concession/Disabled cards to be displayed/shown to crew.
- This is a turn up and go service, you do not need to book a specific sailing unless the timetable is marked A or B.
- The crew are present for your safety. Follow their guidance and instructions at all times.
