ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (A814 DUMBARTON TO ARROCHAR ROAD, HELENSBURGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024



On Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> May 2024, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will make it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on That length of A814 Dumbarton to Arrochar Road, from its junction with C69 Glen Douglas Road in a northerly direction to its junction with B838 Church Road, Arrochar for a distance of 5.3 Kilometres or thereby.

The restrictions imposed by this Order which are required because essential works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road will be effective, when indicated by signs, between the hours of 0600 and 2000 from the 29<sup>th</sup> of May to 12<sup>th</sup> June 2024, or until the works are complete, whichever is the earlier. Amnesty periods will be provided Monday to Friday at 0830 to 0930 and 1430 to 1530. Exceptions will apply to a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, a vehicle being used for carrying out the works or a vehicle requiring access/egress to and from affected properties when possible and as directed by traffic management operatives on site.
