ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (C30 FORD-KILMAHA-BARNALINE ROAD) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024



On Thursday 9th May 2024, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will make it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on that length of C30 Ford-Kilmaha-Barnaline Road from its junction with the East Lochaweside Road (B840) at Ford, to its junction with the Kilmelford - Kilchrenan Road (C29) at Druimdarroch for a distance of 16.5 Kilometres or thereby.

The restrictions imposed by this Order which are required because essential works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road will be effective, when indicated by signs, between the hours of from 2359 on 21st of May 2024 to 2359 on 21st of May 2025, or until the works are complete, whichever is the earlier. Exceptions will apply to a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.
