





## **Community Consultation**

Dear Resident,

You are receiving this letter as part of the consultation process for the 2025 Dunoon Presents Argyll Rally which will be held on the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> June 2025.

For the first time the rally is proposing to use the road your property is located on with a closure extending from south of Millhouse to just beyond the junction for Ardlamont Point, as shown on the attached map. The road highlighted in red indicates the extent of the proposed closure. This road would be used for one special stage\*, hereby referred to as SS14 - Millhouse. This special stage would run on the Saturday afternoon of the event only within the times detailed below:

Road Closes	Road Opens
12:45	17:45

Please note that the stated timings are, at this point, provisional / for indication only, and subject to slight change. The "Road Opens" time is a latest time and wherever possible roads will be opened prior to these times.

We are currently seeking the views of all stakeholders prior to any plans being finalised and as this is the first time we have proposed using this section of road we wanted to ensure all affected residents and businesses were aware of the proposal at the earliest opportunity. <sup>\*</sup>Special Stages are the competitive element of a rally. These are held on closed roads with competing cars traversing them individually, against the clock, with the aim of setting the quickest time.
