Argyll and Bute Council propose to make a Traffic Regulation Order to introduce amendments to the existing 20mph speed restrictions on the following length of roads:

Lochdonhead

That length of the Salen-Craignure-Iona Ferry Road (Route A849) adjacent to Lochdonhead Primary School, Lochdonhead, Isle of Mull, extending from a point 22 metres or thereby southwest of the extended centreline of the Gorten Road (No 13) south-westerly to a point 20m southwest of the extended centre line of Swan Drive, for a distance of 465 metres or thereby.
