

Craignure Marine Infrastructure Liaison Group

Terms of Reference

Argyll and Bute Council is in the process of developing a ferry terminal at Craignure to replace the existing structure which is coming to the end of its useful life. A STAG has been completed. The Craignure Marine Infrastructure Liaison Group will be a meeting to:

- provide a forum for Mull and Iona Community Councils, hauliers and public transport providers to meet formally with Argyll and Bute Council and Transport Scotland regarding Craignure marine infrastructure.
- be a forum to consult and communicate with Community Council Groups about the needs of the community and the options available to the public bodies for delivering infrastructure which will meet community needs, are affordable, deliverable and be fit for purpose for the next 60+ years.
- be used to provide community feedback to the Councils Harbour Board, Craignure Pier Development (CPD) Working Group and the relevant boards within Transport Scotland.
- will NOT be used to discuss ferry timetabling which will be left to other established groups.
- the group will be chaired by an Elected Member of Argyll and Bute Council.
- the group will meet a minimum of twice a year, but the frequency is expected to be higher particularly during development of the detailed design. The group will determine the meeting frequency.
