B – Bookable late sailing Monday to Saturday. To be booked by noon 1 (one) day in advance by calling the ferry office on 01496 840681. **No late sailing can be booked if 0615 has been booked prior.**

- It is advisable for passengers to be in attendance on the pier **10** minutes prior to sailing time for crew to organise boarding and conduct safety announcements. **The vessel has a quick turnaround at Feolin, please ensure you arrive at Feolin before the vessel's departure time from Port Askaig.**
