

NOTICE TO MARINERS 02/26

CARRADALE 11.05.26

Mariners are advised that dive inspection and survey works will be conducted by Cromarty Firth Marine Services on behalf of Argyll & Bute Council. The dive team are due to mobilise w/c 11th May 2026 and begin works on Tuesday 12th for a period of 2 days. The dive team will display "Flag Alpha" in a prominent position and maintain a VHF radio watch on channel 16 throughout the duration of the works. Mariners operating in or near the area of Carradale Harbour are therefore requested to maintain their obligations under the IRPCS where they should maintain a safe watch, at a safe speed and distance from the site of works, all vessels are therefore requested to make contact with the dive team on approach or departure from the harbour, where they should comply fully so as not to hamper or compromise works.

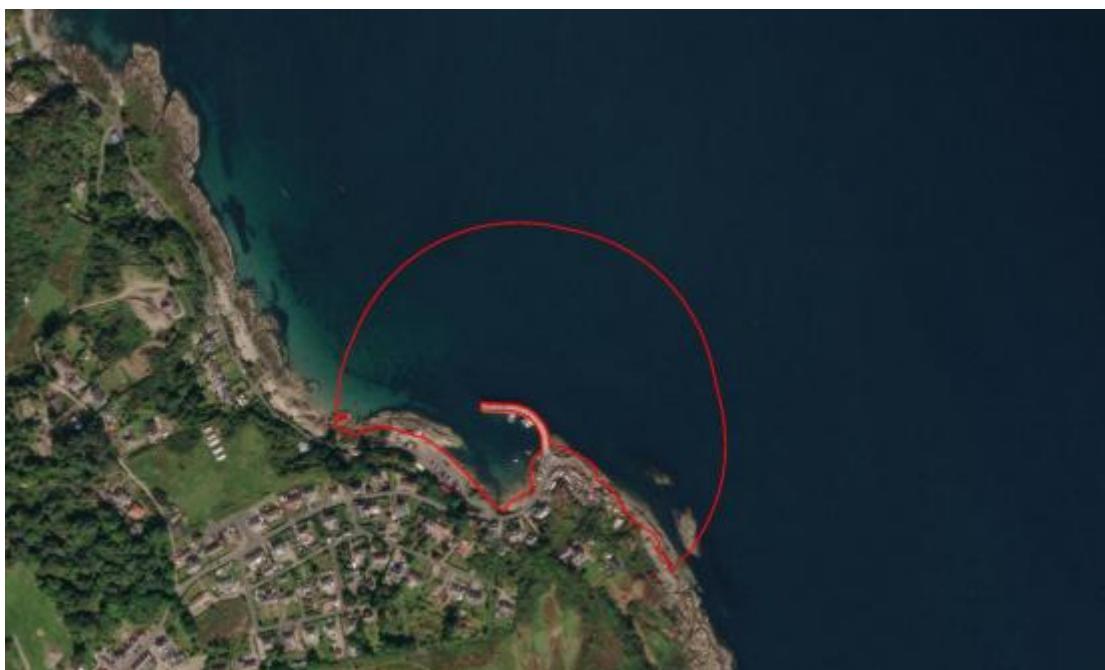


FIG: RED LINE DENOTES HARBOUR LIMIT
