

For people who have symptoms

Got symptoms of COVID-19, close contact (past 48 hours) of someone who tested positive or told to book a test by Test and Protect?

Book a free PCR test.

If symptomatic, book a test within 5 days of symptoms starting.

How to book a PCR test

- To book a home test kit, or get an appointment at sites in Helensburgh or Oban, go to - www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test or phone 119.
- Home test kits are available to anyone living on mainland Argyll, Mull, Islay, Jura or Bute.
 - Home test kits are posted to your home and should arrive the day after you order them.
 - Home test kits should be returned by priority post box where available - <https://www.royalmail.com/priority-postboxes>.
 - Completed tests in Islay should be placed in the COVID Drop Box at Islay Hospital.
- Some islands have individual testing pathways in place as they cannot receive home tests, details can be found at: bit.ly/TestOnIslands
